F.U.R.R.Y. AWARD

The Fairport Service Team would like to take this opportunity to explain exactly what the F.U.R.R.Y award is and why it is important.

Sometimes there is a person who comes into our lives and leaves an indelible mark on us. Sometimes these friends are taken away from us too soon. Carolyn Bayne was such a person, and very dedicated to Fairport Girl Scouting. She was far from perfect. Those of us who knew her can attest to that. We can also tell of her virtues.

Carolyn was a consummate Girl Scout. She believed in what Girl Scouting stands for, and she did her best to spread the word in all walks of her life. The term “green blood” truly defined Carolyn. Her belief in the virtues of Girl Scouting was so strong that she could be heard recruiting help for Piperwood Day Camp while standing on a street corner waiting for the light to change. By the way, she was persuasive and successful at it.

Because of Carolyn’s commitment to Girl Scouts, the Fairport Service Team felt the best way to honor her was to create an award to be given to a Girl Scout who showed those qualities as well. Carolyn’s camp name was “Furry”. We chose the acronym, F.U.R.R.Y., which stands for **F**airport’s **U**nique **R**ecognition for a **R**esourceful **Y**oung woman.

It is the intention of the Fairport Service Team that this award be given each year to one girl who exemplifies Girl Scouting. This does not mean that it HAS to be given every year. It is awarded only when a truly deserving girl has been identified. Girls in Cadette and Senior age levels may be nominated for this award. Attached is a list of criteria as well as an application form.

The F.U.R.R.Y. award was originally funded by memorials made to the Service Unit in Carolyn’s name. The Service Unit continues to fund this award as a budget item. The Awardee will receive a check from the Service Unit in the amount of \$100.00. This award is a celebration of the spirit of Girl Scouting that Carolyn manifested in her lifetime.
